2015 ANNUAL PERMIT APPLICATION DUE

Hazardous Materials Activity Operational Permit



The Colorado Springs Fire Dept. reminds you to update your annual Hazardous Materials Permit for 2015. January 1, 2015 permit year roll over requires that you enter the system and update your permit.

Provision of the Fire Code states, "An operational permit is required to store, transport on site, dispense, use or handle hazardous materials in excess of the amounts listed in Table 105.5.20." If not previously enrolled, apply for your permit and enter your facility information through the online web-based reporting program "HAMMERS." Apply online at the web address on this card.

2015 Hazardous Materials Activity Operational Permit

As in previous years, this notification is being sent to you as our records indicate that your business qualifies for the Hazardous Materials Activity Operational Permit through the International Fire Code Hazardous Materials Management Program.

Update Permit - Annual Roll Over

Once the CSFD annual permit application is completed and submitted in HAMMERS, all of your facility data remains saved in the HAMMERS program. However, each new calendar year you must sign in and update your current year submission data after January 1st or anytime thereafter if changes occur at your facility. Even if you have no changes, the current year roll over submission must be completed.

1. Sign Into the Application, username/password required.
2. Update User Profile.
3. Click the Start Application link.
4. Click on the Facility Name in the list.
5. Click on the Edit link next to the year you wish to update your report.
6. Once you update all your information on the Facility Home Page, click complete Step 4 to certify-submit report. The administrator will then be notified by email that your report was submitted.

Access is unlimited from any electronic device with internet access.

Annual Inspection

You will be contacted by the Div of the Fire Marshal to schedule your 2015 Annual Permit Inspection.

Annual Permit

The 2015 Permit will be issued to your facility following completion of your HAMMERS application and facility inspection. Fees are associated with the annual permit.

TIER I/II Chemical Inventory Report

Completed Tier II forms are due March 1st to the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC), State & Federal agencies. Due to the large volume of files, the City of Colorado Springs LEPC does not accept paper, email, electronic device (disk/USB) submittals. Tier I/II Chemical Inventory Reports are to be completed and submitted through the CSFD HAMMERS program.
