Because Arapahoe Fire Protection, Inc.’s (AFP) performance is under review [reference August 12, 2016’s Fire Board of Appeals (FBA) meeting minutes], Mr. Wallace asked Fire Marshal (FM) Lacey if the Colorado Springs Fire Department (CSFD) has concerns relevant to approving the license. FM Lacey reported that CSFD does not have issue with AFP’s application for a Fire Alarm Contractor A license. 
**Motion made by Mr. Doiron to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mr. Putnam.**
