Hazardous Materials Activity Operational Permit



The Colorado Springs Fire Department reminds you to update your annual Hazardous Materials Permit. January 1 permit year rollover requires that you enter the HAMMERS program and update your permit. If not previously enrolled, apply for your permit and enter your facility and chemical information through the on-line web-based reporting program "HAMMERS." Apply on-line at the web address on the this card.

All future annual Hazardous Materials Permit notices and correspondence will be via HAMMERS e-mail.

Hazardous Materials Activity Operational Permit

As in previous years, this notification is being sent to you as our records indicate that your business qualifies for the Hazardous Materials Activity Operational Permit through the International Fire Code Hazardous Materials Management Program.

Update Permit - Annual Rollover

Once the CSFD annual permit application is completed and submitted in HAMMERS, all of your facility data remains saved in the HAMMERS program. However, each new calendar year, after January 1st it's your responsibility to log-in to <https://hammers.springsgov.com> to update and rollover the facility's current year submission data. Whenever changes to your facility occur throughout the year, a submission update is also required.

1. Sign Into the Application, username/password required.
2. Update User Profile.
3. Click the Start Application link.
4. Click on the Facility Name in the list.
5. Click on the Edit link next to the year you wish to update your report.
6. Once you update all your information on the Facility Home Page, click complete Step 4 to certify-submit report. The administrator will then be notified by email that your report was submitted.

Access is unlimited from any electronic device with internet access.

Annual Inspection

You will be contacted by the Division of the Fire Marshal to schedule your Annual Permit Inspection.

Annual Permit

The Annual Permit will be issued to your facility following completion of your HAMMERS application and facility inspection. Fees are associated with the annual permit.

Tier II Reporting

Beginning for reporting year 2015 (reports to be filed by March 1, 2016), facility owners and operators are required to submit their Tier II reports electronically to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment. Facilities are not required to provide the same report to the local emergency planning committee (LEPC) or the local fire department unless those agencies maintain local reporting requirements.

The CSFD/COS-LEPC does NOT require the same report.
