



Important Information Concerning Tier II Reporting for RY 2015

Colorado is instituting a single-point submission process for Tier II reporting.

Beginning for reporting year 2015 (reports to be filed by March 1, 2016), facility owners and operators are required to submit their Tier II reports electronically to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment. Facilities are not required to provide the same report to the local emergency planning committee (LEPC) or the local fire department **unless** those agencies maintain local reporting requirements.

Please check with your LEPC and fire department to determine if they require direct Tier II reporting to their agency or have any additional requirements. Tier II data submitted to the state will be distributed to the LEPCs and local fire departments through the [Colorado Emergency Planning Committee](#) (CEPC).
