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20-29—Colorado Springs Utilities Electric Cost Adjustment and Gas Cost Adjustment

October 2020

Purpose

The purpose of this audit was to evaluate whether Colorado Springs Utilities (Utilities) prepared the Electric Cost Adjustment (ECA) and Gas Cost Adjustment (GCA) in accordance with the approved tariffs. The methodology was compared to prior filings for consistency and calculations were tested for accuracy.

Summary

Based on our review of calculations and related support filed with our office, we conclude that the proposed adjustment submitted by Utilities complied with approved tariffs. The calculations were accurate and consistent with prior filings.

For the November 1, 2020 effective date, Utilities provided ECA and GCA adjustments for consideration by City Council.

The supply credit for large power customers is being reduced in accordance with previously approved guidance. Under Utilities' Board approved guidance, Utilities will submit ECA and GCA adjustments quarterly to manage balances within \$5 million over or under collected.
