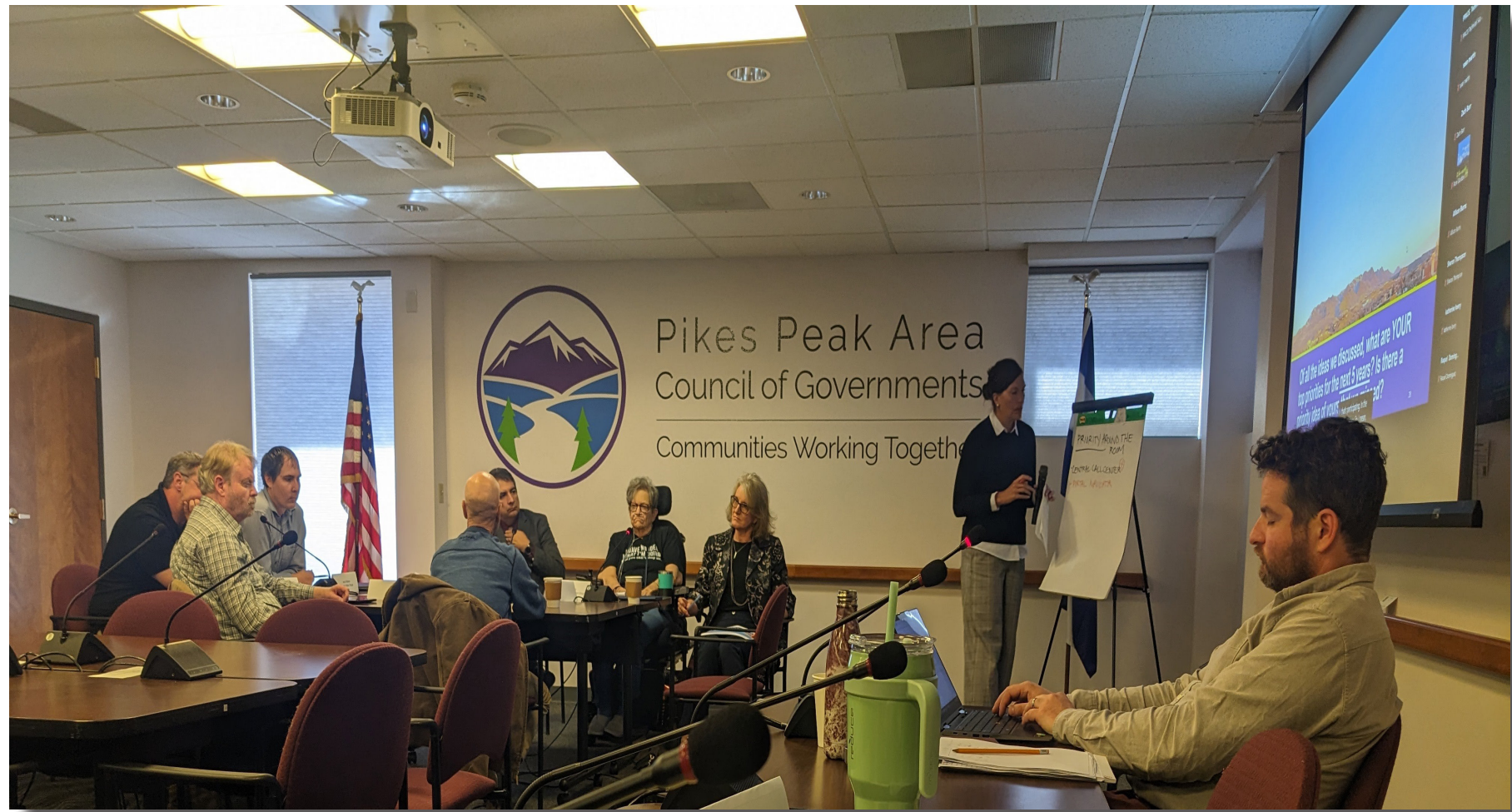

▶ Key Themes 2050 Specialized Transportation Plan

- Create an **inclusive transportation system** that focuses on the experience of the rider.
- Make booking, canceling, or reserving single and/or reoccurring rides **easier and adaptable** to changes in everyday life.
- Increase the **coordination and collaboration** between organizations to maximize the impact of limited resources for riders.
- Cultivate **partnerships between organizations** to support a network of services.
- Provide **educational opportunities for riders** to learn more about the different services and eligibility requirements.
- Eliminate **“no-ride scenarios”** for those needing to ride transit, paratransit, or specialized transportation.



▶ Key Themes 2050 Regional Transit Plan

- Create a plan that is **aspirational, actionable, and responsive** to the region’s population growth and development.
- Connect transit to **regional destinations**, like the airport, higher education institutions, and military installations.
- **Improve connectivity** to Downtown Colorado Springs for pedestrians, cyclists, and transit riders.
- Ensure residents have **access to transit** when commuting to and from jobs to help grow the region’s workforce.
- Improve the **accessibility and safety** of bus stops and transfer locations.
- Identify **partnership opportunities** to enhance transit services.
